ONE: The name of this corporation is Tamang Cooperation Society.

TWO: This Corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes. The specific purposes for which this corporation is organized are:

2.1 visions:

We the Tamang people living in the United States of America envisions full of joy, prosperity, generosity, cooperative and global peace by advancement of socio culture, education, heath, economic development and sustainable natural environment among the Tamang people and their surrounding communities.

2.2 Mission:


Mutual cooperation for lasting positive changes the lives of Tamang people and their surrounding communities.

2.3 Goals:


(a) This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
